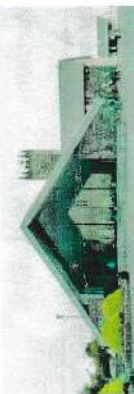

**BIG BREAKFAST**

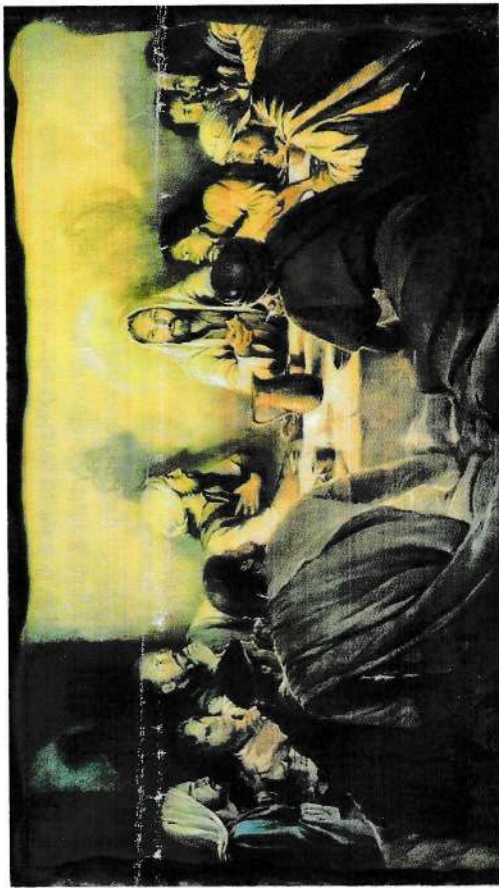
