BROKEN OPEN: HOW DIFFICULT TIMES CAN HELP US GROW

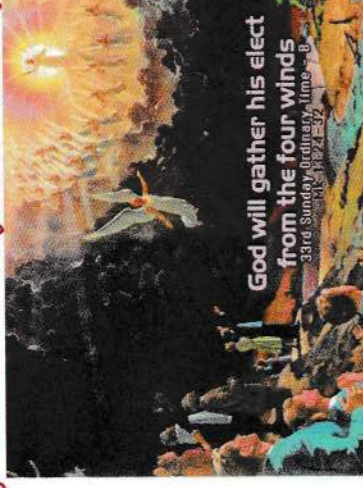
