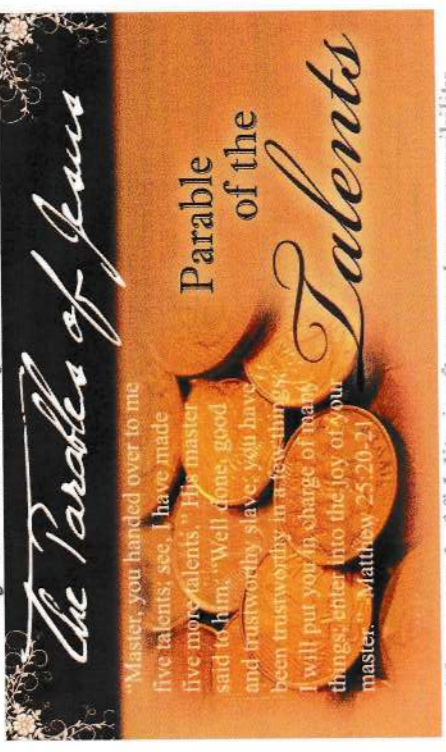

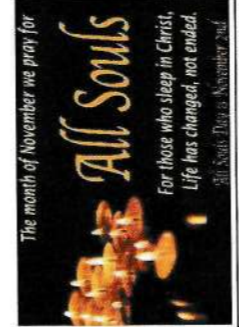
Please Note:
