The initiative will involve all the Shrines of the world in a special way, so that they might encourage the faithful, families and communities to recite the Rosary to pray for an end to the pandemic. Pope Francis opened the Marian month of prayer on 1st May with a Rosary broadcast across Vatican media's platforms. Each day will see Vatican News broadcast the recitation of the Rosary at 6pm Rome time (5pm Irish time) from the various Shrines taking part in the initiative.
The Pope will close the initiative on 31st May with another specially broadcast Rosary.
