Access to the event will be available from 7:20pm with a start at 7:30pm sharp.

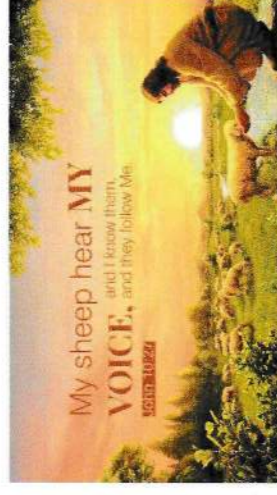
