For all others the Masses will be streamed via webcam in the usual way.

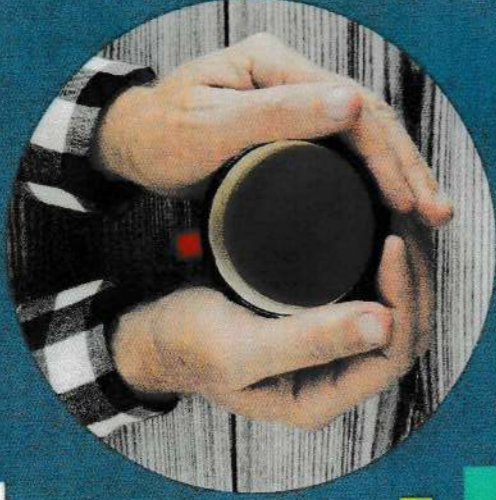

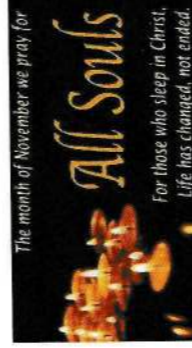

Sat 11.00am to 5.30pm and Sun 12 noon to 6pm. Please follow the notices.

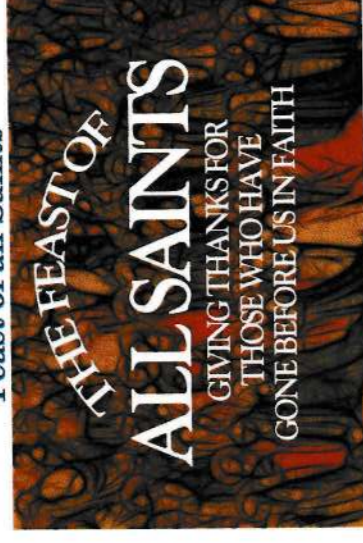
