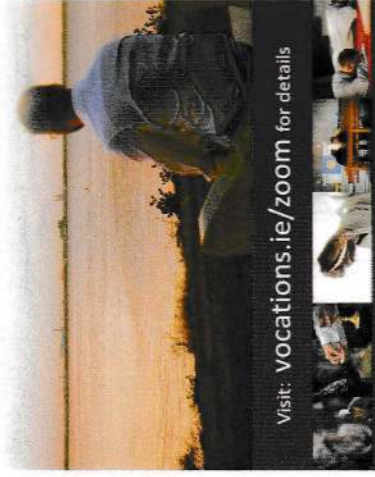
LORD TEACH US TO PRAY

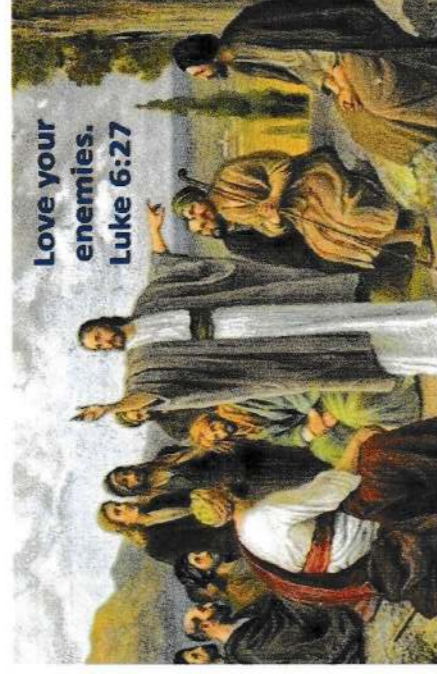
