JOINING OUR LADY AT KNOCK

In normal circumstances, our diocesan pilgrimage to Knock would have been due to take place on Sunday 21 June. My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Blessed Sacrament.

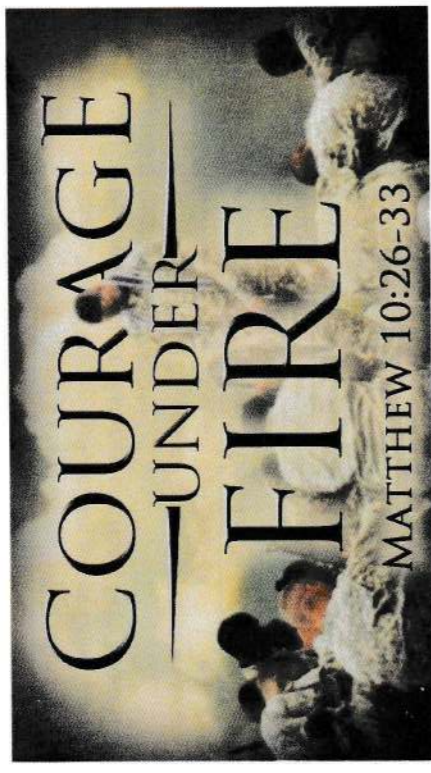
I love You above all things, and I long for You in my soul.
