The Mass celebrated at 11.00am in **St. John's Ballymaghery will now be celebrated at 11.30am**. Baptisms will take place at 12.30pm.

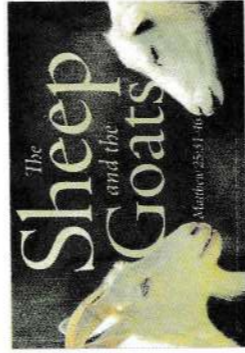
