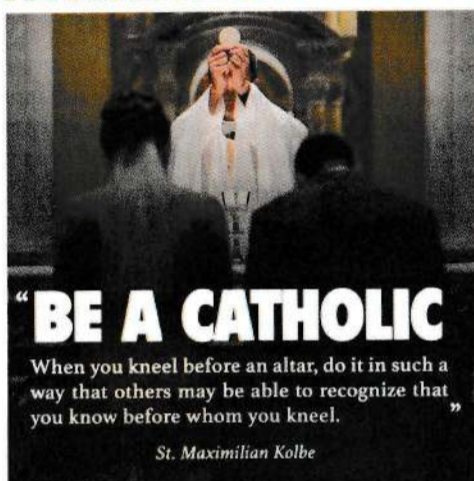

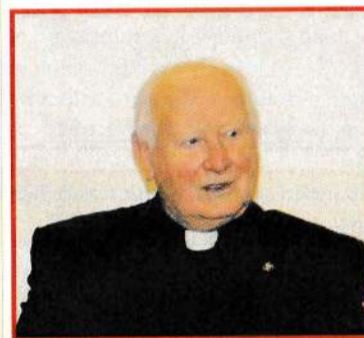

A number of parishioners have been inquiring as to the outcome of the recent parish survey. The outcome was as follows: 356 surveys returned. **79% supported the Finance Committee proposal. 11% asked for the house to be demolished. 10% put forward a number of different options.** The Finance Committee and the Diocese are considering how best to proceed. A recommendation will be brought forward in due course.

**2019 GUIDED TOURS OF NEWRY CATHEDRAL** Following the interest shown in the guided tours of the Cathedral over the past six years, there will be a further series of guided tours of the Cathedral on the following dates: **Wednesday 17 July 2019 at 2.00pm** **Wednesday 31 July 2019 at 7.00pm** **\*\* Please note:** This tour on the 31 July will focus only on the images in the stained glass windows of Cathedral, **Wednesday 14 August 2019 at 2.00pm** **Wednesday 28 August 2019 at 7.00pm** Each tour will take approximately 90 minutes Please meet at the main door of the Cathedral. You will hear the story of the building of the Cathedral, 1825 -1829, and of the later extensions. The history of its stained glass, marble altars, sculptures and magnificent mosaics will also be explained. **There is no charge for these tours.**

Corpus Christi (Body and Blood of Christ) is a Eucharistic solemnity, or better, the solemn commemoration of the institution of that sacrament. It is, moreover, the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ.

The Mass and the Office for the feast was composed by St. Thomas Aquinas upon the request of Pope Urban IV in the year 1264. It is unquestionably a classic piece of liturgical work, wholly in accord with the best liturgical traditions. . . It is a perfect work of art.
