Martin Goss is a former History teacher in St Colman's and Secretary of the Dromore Diocesan Historical Society

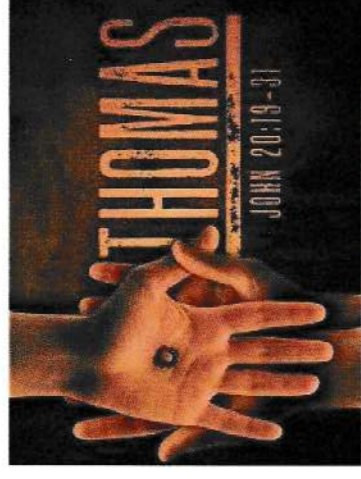
