Dear Father, Deacon,

I hope you are managing to prepare for the Christmas weekend despite all the uncertainty and pressures over Covid-19.

At a recent meeting with the Chief Medical Advisor (NI) and Chief Scientific Advisor (NI), representatives from the Churches in Northern Ireland were able to discuss the current coronavirus challenges. I want to share with you a number of important points that emerged from the meeting.

The CMO and CSA made it clear that the risk of transmission from the Omicron variant of Covid-19 is substantially higher than that of the Delta variant and therefore so also is the risk of contagion in any small, medium or large gathering. The Health authorities are anxious to avoid a build-up of patients in our hospital system over the next two months. They mentioned that the rate of infection is expected to peak at Christmas time and last for around two months, after which time, it is hoped that with the booster programme, it should decline.

Specifically in relation to Churches over this period they appeal to all Churches and faith communities:

- To responsibly assess the risk of every activity you plan to undertake.
- To maximise the use of all established mitigations, notably VENTILATION, SOCIAL DISTANCING and WEARING OF MASKS.
- To minimise all activities which bring people together and which are not essential to the integrity of our worship and faith celebration of the Christmas season.

In relation to the Sacrament of Reconciliation it was mentioned that there is a very high risk to priests and penitents from hearing successive confessions in a room, even of moderate size, unless it is extremely well ventilated. It was observed that the virus stays in the air for several hours unless the ventilation is very effective. Please take this into account if you are hearing confessions in the days prior to, and after, Christmas.

I will let you know if we receive any further guidelines in the coming days.

Let us endeavour to offer a message of hope to all our people and to society over the Christmas season.

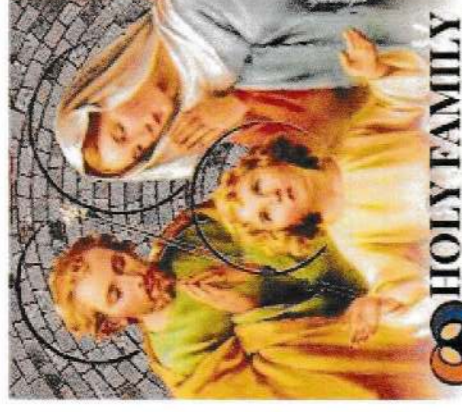
