Adoration in Ballygorian has resumed and now changed to **Thursdays 7.30pm - 8.30pm**

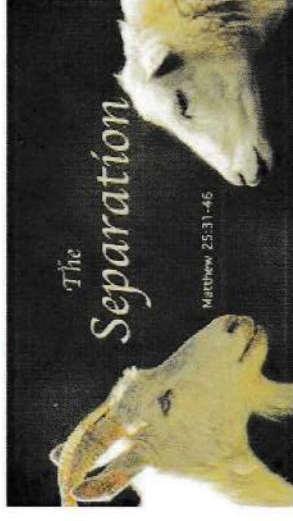


Adoration will take place every Tuesday evening at 8.00pm with the Rosary being recited in Ballymaghery. All are welcome.
