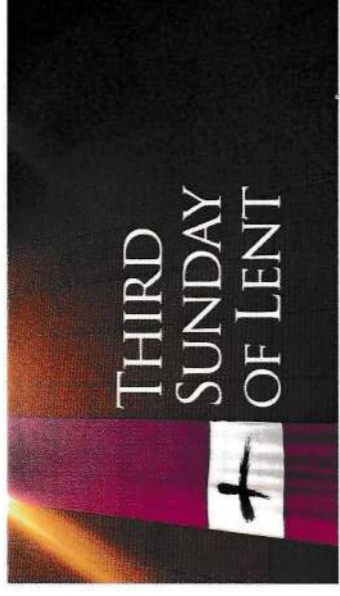
Adoration in Ballygorian has resumed and now changed to Thursdays 7.30pm – 8.30pm
