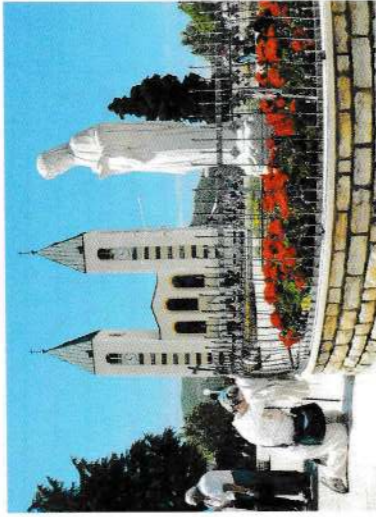


Come visit the Crib. Picture the Holy Family on that first Christmas night. Say a prayer of thanks for the gift of life, family and friendship

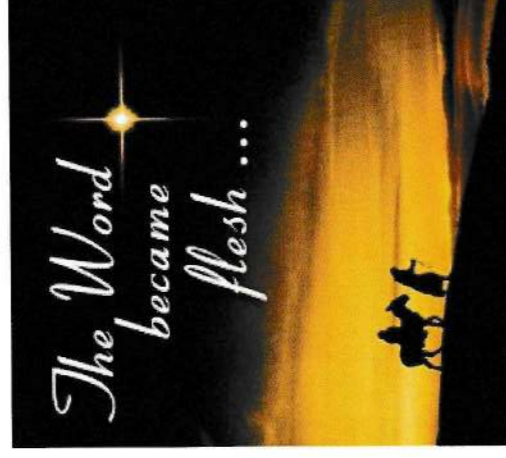
